**Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper** and the **Town of Niagara** are working together to complete restoration along Cayuga Creek in order to restore natural habitat, improve community access to the creek, and help reduce flooding where possible. Bordered by Cayuga Village, Roberts Drive and Porter Road, this project area includes rare forested wetland habitat and is home to abundant plant and animal life.

**Join us for a project update!** The project design is more than 50 percent complete. Come learn from the project team about:

- Why this site is considered to be rare in the Town of Niagara and is of exceptional ecological value,
- How this project seeks to restore natural stream flow to help reduce the potential for flooding associated with the creek within the project site,
- The future vision for the property in creating opportunities for outdoor recreational activities like hiking, fishing, and birding, and
