Hometown Hero Banner Project for Town of Niagara, NY INSTRUCTION SHEET

Many towns and villages throughout NY state have taken the opportunity to honor the servicemen and servicewomen who served in the US Armed Forces by displaying banners with their photos, rank, and branch of service. These banners are purchased by their families or friends and then are prominently displayed through the summer months in Veterans Park and o various streets throughout the community. Applications are taken from Jan. 1st-December 31st, for the following year. **PLEASE contact historian Pete Ames with any questions. 716-297-4429.**

Banner Information

The banners are 18" by 36", double-sided with photo, made from vinyl material and will include the following factual information: Name of the serviceman/woman; branch of service; era of service and special honors (Purple Heart, Gold or Silver Star) and sponsors names. Banners are displayed on poles located in Veterans Park, Lockport Road, Military Road, and other main routes through the Town of Niagara. They will hang from Memorial Day through Veteran's Day and then be stored for the winter, to be hung again the following year. The placement will be in alphabetical order and we can't honor requests for specific locations. At the end of the season, banners are stored at the Parks Department. If the banner is stored by the Town of Niagara Parks Department, it will be rehung each year until it wears out. The banner is the property of the family and can be returned to them if requested at the end of the season, but will not be rehung again the next year if the family takes it. The company states that the banner will usually last up to between 3-5 years depending on weather conditions.

Requirements

All service men and women must meet these requirements:

- 1. Have resided within the town limits of Town of Niagara, New York presently or at some point in their lifetime or had a business in the Town of Niagara.
- 2. Did serve or are serving our country in Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, Marines, Space Force, or Navy, active or reserves.
- 3. Must be serving currently, or be an honorably discharged veteran, MIA, or died in the line of duty.
- 4. PLEASE provide us with a copy of the veterans' DD-214 or equivalent paperwork.

Banner Pricing

Each banner will cost the sponsor, family/friend a total of \$150. This includes the double sided vinyl banner, hardware for hanging, and shipping costs.

Sponsorship/Donations

For individuals or businesses who would like to be a sponsor without purchasing a banner, monetary donations will be used for expenses beyond the cost of the banners and hardware.

- 1. Reside within the Town of Niagara, NY presently or at some point in their lifetime or had a business in the Town of Niagara.
- 2. Did serve or are serving our country in one of the following: Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, National Guard, Marines or Navy, active or reserves.
- 3. Each serviceman/servicewoman must be presently serving, or be an honorably discharged veteran, MIA or died in the line of duty.
