Historians Corner

Over a six month period as Town of Niagara historian, I researched information to document the five different elected officials in the town since its' inception in 1812. Fortunately, I did have some help in gathering the information and putting the results together into Excel spreadsheets. Recently, the results were posted on the Town of Niagara website, so anyone can search or sort any of those positions. If you are interested in seeing who served over the years, go to the website, www.townofniagara.com., click on Departments, go to Town Historian, and there are 5 links located there to get to the positions. The following is a summary of what we found.

Over the 212 year period, there were 43 different supervisors, and 43 different town clerks. A total of 40 different council members (since 1942), 93 different highway superintendents and 74 different justices.

The first evidence that I find regarding the Council or Board of the Town of Niagara are the Town of Niagara Justices of the Peace. The supervisors are listed from the beginning in 1812, but the Justices of the Peace do not appear until 1831. From 1831 until 1942, all 4 of the council were Justices of the Peace. Starting in 1942, one of the 4 was a councilman until 1944. Then the board was split with 2 Justices and 2 Councilmen each, and that continued through 1977. Since 1978, all members of the board have been Councilmen or Councilwomen and the Justices have held a separate position as members of the court.

Over the years, many people served multiple terms and some actually held different positions at various times. I am always collecting more of the history of the Town of Niagara, so if you have any pictures, or any documents related to people or businesses in the ton, please call me at 716-297-4429. Is Your House Number Visible?

If an emergency responder needed to get to your house, could it be easily found? Street numbers of your house or building should be at least 3 inches in height and displayed in a manner that is plainly legible from the street at all times between sunrise and sunset. The color of the numbers should be in sharp contrast to the background. For houses far from the road or obstructed by trees a number should appear on **both sides** of the mailbox which is helpful for anyone trying to locate your home.
